

Leadership Greater Hartford Partners with Citizens Network to Address Pressing Issues in Capital Region

On October 12th the Leadership Greater Hartford (LGH) Board of Directors voted to enter into a collaborative partnership with the **Citizens Network of the Capital Region, Inc. (CNCR)**. LGH's mission is to awaken and help realize the leadership potential of people and inspire them to build strong and vibrant workplaces and communities throughout Greater Hartford. Courtney Bourns, President of CNCR, stated that the partnership will allow the two organizations to work together in a way that can be synergistic and supportive of both organizations' missions.

According to LGH Board chairman Claire Burns, the purpose for the partnership is "to support each other's mission in a way that strengthens our mutual commitment to the people of the Greater Hartford region." She adds that the partnership with CNCR is a vehicle for "encouraging LGH graduates to provide leadership and support for public policy initiatives that address issues affecting the vitality and quality of life for the region's citizens."

CNCR currently is preparing an electronic poll to over 500 citizens of the region asking them to vote on what they believe to be the most important issue facing the region. Then a citizen's study committee will be formed to study the issue and make some findings and recommendations for public discussion and debate. CNCR is looking both for people who would like to be polled and for volunteers to provide leadership for this new initiative.
